

HEALTH & SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of R Cockram services, approved by its proprietor that operations carried out by the company are in accordance with the requirements of the Health & Safety at work act 1974, both in the spirit of the act and its legal obligations. The company accepts its responsibilities towards its employees and any other person who may be affected by the work carried out by the company. The company will ensure the work under its control is carried out in such a way as to minimise the risk to the Health & Safety of its employees and any other person who could affected.

All managers shall ensure that persons carrying out for or on behalf are adequately trained to enable them to understand their responsibilities and be 'competent 'in their work. New employees / operatives will receive training prior to commencing work and all employees /operatives will be inducted prior to commencing work on new sites. We take very seriously any persons who fail to comply with their legal duties undermining the integrity of our strict safety procedures.

The company will provide safe plant, equipment and tools that conform to EC, BS and other relevant standards and that safe systems of work are in place and followed. With regards to safe handling of materials the company has COSHH procedures and a COSHH manual in place to ensure safe practices when handling hazardous materials. In this way the company will ensure they will provide a safe place of work and a safe working environment for its employees and ensure other persons are not adversely affected by the company's work.

R Cockram Services assisted by Lodge Incorporated Ltd, Health & Safety advisers, will monitor the operation of this policy. Lodge incorporated Ltd will be available to advise all employees on matters relating to Health & Safety.

This policy statement and the Health & Safety manual will be reviewed by R Cockram Services on an annual basis and updated as either legislation changes or working practices change.
